STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-four, clause three of the school laws, in relation to the powers and duties of superintending school committees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section fifty-four, clause three of the
2 school laws, is hereby amended, by adding the words
3 “ or may render valid by endorsement any graded
4 certificates issued to teachers by normal school princi-
5 pals, county supervisors, or state superintendent of
6 common schools,” so that the entire clause shall read
7 thus : “ They shall give to each candidate found
8 competent, a certificate that he is qualified to govern
9 said school and instruct in the branches above named,
10 and such other branches as may be necessary to be

11 taught therein, or may render valid by endorsement
12 any graded certificates issued to teachers by normal
13 school principals, county supervisors, or state super-
14 intendent of common schools.”

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
