STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional to "an act to incorporate the Portland and Rutland Railroad Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the location of the Portland, 2 Rutland, Oswego and Chicago Railroad Company, 3 from its eastern terminus (which is a point to be 4 determined upon, either west of the Saco river or 5 north of Standish east of said river, and in either case 6 upon the line of some one of the railroads in the 7 counties of York, Oxford and Cumberland, which at 8 the date of the incorporation of said company had been 9 built or authorized to be built) towards its western 10 terminus, is hereby extended to the first day of Janu-11 ary, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and

12 seventy-two, and the time for the construction and 13 completion of said railroad is hereby extended one 14 year from the time authorized therefor by the act of 15 incorporation, approved March sixth, eighteen hundred 16 and sixty-eight; and any attempt by said company, 17 its officers, agents or servants to locate a railroad, or 18 any part of a railroad, upon any pretended location 19 between the eastern terminus, as above defined, and 20 the city of Portland, shall make the original act of 21 incorporation of said company, and all additional acts 22 thereto, void. Nothing in this act contained shall be 23 construed as prohibiting the city of Portland from 24 authorizing any railroad company to cross or pass any 25 way or street in said city.

SECT. 2. Said company is hereby authorized to 2 increase its number of directors by vote of the stock-3 holders, not to exceed fifteen in all.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
