STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of a system of storm warnings in the
State of Maine.

WHEREAS, by an act of congress passed at the last
2 session, the secretary of war was authorized to estab-
3 lish a system of storm warnings, and believing that
4 such a plan if properly carried out would be of much
5 practical advantage to the industries of the country ;
6 therefore,

Resolved, That congress be requested, through the
2 secretary of war, to test a system of storm warnings
3 by means of the telegraph and signals in this state for
4 the benefit of agriculture and commerce, and protec-
5 tion against floods.

Resolved, That a copy of these resolves be sent to the
2 secretary of war, and also to each of our senators and
3 representatives in congress, requesting them to use
4 their influence in furtherance of the above design and
the testing of the plan in our state.
