STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Joseph A. Chambers.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the state treasury,
2 in money not otherwise appropriated, to Joseph A.
3 Chambers, the father of John W. Chambers, who en-
4 listed in the thirty-second Maine regiment on the
5 nineteenth day of February, in the year eighteen hun-
6 dred and sixty-four, and while on duty at Augusta, in
7 the service of the United States, contracted diptheria
8 and typhoid fever, of which diseases he died in hos-
9 pital at Augusta, Maine, on the twenty-first day of
10 April of the same year, without receiving the bounty
11 of three hundred dollars due him from the state, the
12 sum of four hundred and twenty-two dollars, the same
13 being the amount of three hundred dollars bounty and
14 interest, from the twenty-second day of April, in the
15 year eighteen hundred and sixty-four.
