STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Medway Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

William B. Hayford, S. F. Hersey, Davis R. Stock-
2 well, W. H. McCrillis, S. H. Blake, their associates,
3 successors and assigns, are hereby incorporated into a
4 body politic and corporate by the name of the Medway
5 Railway Company, with authority to build a railroad
6 from some point in the town of Mattawamkeag, on the
7 line of the European and North American Railway,
8 through township A, range five, west east line of the
9 state, to some point in the town of Medway, the dis-
10 tance being about twelve miles ; with all the powers,
11 privileges, duties and liabilities of similar corporations
12 according to the laws of the state ; with the right to

13 lease their road, and issue bonds for a sum not exceed-
14 ing three-fourths of their capital stock.
