STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT relative to pretended savings banks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Any person not authorized by act of the legislature
2 who shall advertise his business as that of a savings
3 bank, or shall receive deposits under pretense of con-
4 ducting a savings bank, shall be punished by a fine
5 of one hundred dollars for each offence.
