IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT additional to chapter eighteen, section one of the revised statutes, relating to the repairs of highways.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners shall have  
2 power to order the grading of hills in the public roads,  
3 on petition, the same as for altering or laying out of  
4 roads, whenever such alteration by grading shall in  
5 their opinion obviate the necessity for laying out of a  
6 new road.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
