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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE providing for warming the state house by  
steam.

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*Resolved,* That the sum of seven thousand dollars  
2 (\$7,000) be appropriated from the treasury of the  
3 state, for furnishing the labor, material and apparatus  
4 necessary to the introduction of steam for warming the  
5 state house.

*Resolved,* That the governor and council are hereby  
2 empowered to award the contract to the firm or person  
3 whose proposal they shall consider the most advan-  
4 tageous, style, quality and price being considered, and  
5 to make the necessary provision for the oversight and  
6 carrying out of any contract made by them, such con-  
7 tract to be completed on or before the first day of  
8 October next; and if on inspection the governor and  
9 council are satisfied that the work has been performed

10 according to the terms of the contract, the governor  
11 shall draw his warrant upon the treasurer for the pay-  
12 ment of the same.
