STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES in relation to the binding of the acts and
resolves of this state.

Resolved, That the special or private acts and resolves
2 passed since eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, shall
3 constitute the eleventh volume of each, and that the
4 public acts passed since eighteen hundred and sixty-
5 eight, shall constitute a volume.

Resolved, That the secretary of state shall cause a
2 title page, table of contents and general index, to be
3 prepared for each volume; and that he cause the said
4 acts and resolves to be substantially bound and prop-
5 erly lettered for the use of the executive and legislative
6 departments of the government.

Resolved, That a sum not exceeding one hundred and
2 fifty dollars be appropriated to defray the expenses of
3 preparing said title page, table of contents and general

4 index, to be paid under the direction of the governor
5 and council.
