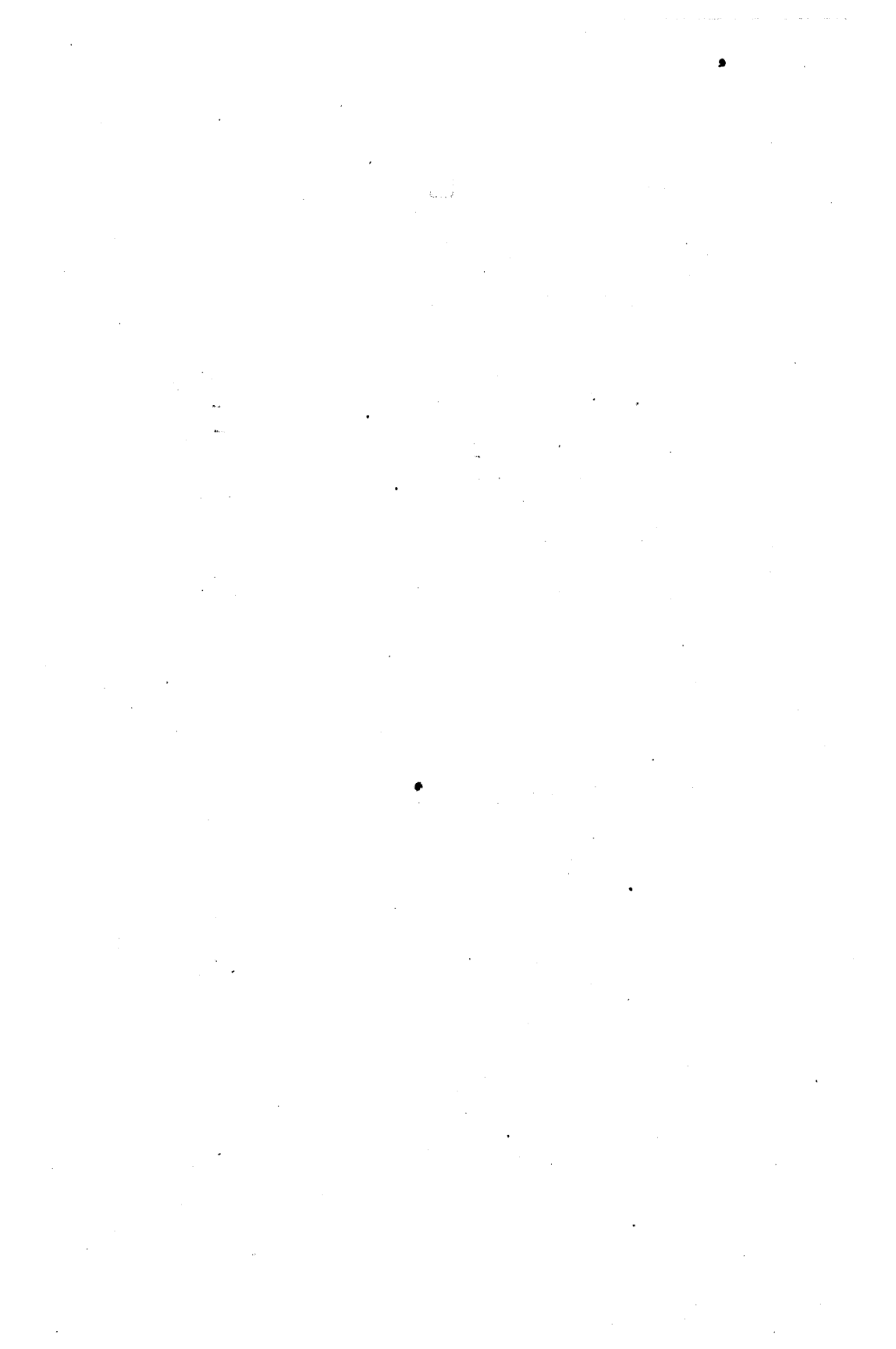
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to the administration of oaths and the acknowledgments of deeds and other papers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Justices of the peace, justices of the
2 peace and quorum, trial justices, and notaries public,
3 authorized to administer oaths and take the acknowl-
4 edgments of deeds and other papers in any county in
5 this state, are hereby authorized to administer oaths
6 and take acknowledgments of deeds and other papers
7 in any other county, and certify the same.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
