STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation for the state library.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars, in
2 addition to the sum allowed by law, be appropriated
3 for the state library, to be expended as follows: four
4 hundred dollars for the purchase of books, and one
5 hundred dollars for incidental expenses.
