STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT to protect bridges from injury by droves of
cattle.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

A town at its annual meeting may, by vote, prescribe
2 and regulate the manner of driving droves of cattle, or
3 other animals over any bridges therein ; and if any
4 person shall drive such animals over any bridge in a
5 manner other than that prescribed in such vote, after
6 having notice in writing thereof, shall forfeit a sum
7 not less than one nor more than fifty dollars, to be
8 recovered by complaint or indictment for the benefit
9 of said town.
