STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT requiring blanks to be furnished to trial justices by the several counties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

The clerk of the supreme judicial court in each
2 county is hereby authorized and required to prepare
3 the various blanks used by trial justices in criminal
4 cases, according to the forms in the "Maine Civil
5 Officer," adapted to his county, and cause them to be
6 printed at the expense of the county, to be kept by
7 him for sale at cost in such quantities as may be from
8 time to time required by such justices.
