## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

---

---

AN ACT to increase the fees of constables for service and return of venires.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Constables for the service, travel and  
2 return of each venire, shall receive one dollar and fifty  
3 cents, and four cents a mile travel, going and returning  
4 distance to be reckoned from town house to shire town,  
5 and no more.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
