STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to an industrial school for girls.

WHEREAS, the necessity of reformatory institutions
2 for youthful offenders is every year becoming more
3 apparent and is enlisting the sympathies of the humane
4 and benevolent; and the state having already pro-
5 vided a reform school for boys, therefore,

Resolved, That a commission of three on an industrial
2 school for girls be appointed by the governor and
3 council, who shall invite proposals for the location and
4 endowment; select a place and devise a plan for the
5 establishment of such a school, and report thereon to
6 the next legislature, together with the amount of ap-
7 propriation necessary on the part of the state to carry
8 the same into successful operation.
