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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

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AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter sixty of the revised statutes, relating to divorce.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter sixty of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows :

4 Sect. 9. Within three years after a judgment on a  
5 libel for divorce, a new trial may be granted as to the  
6 alimony or specific sum decreed ; and also as to the  
7 divorce, when the parties have not cohabited, or either  
8 contracted a new marriage since the former trial, on  
9 such terms in either case as the court may impose.

SECT. 2 This act shall take effect on approval.
