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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

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### AN ACT relating to fencing railroads.

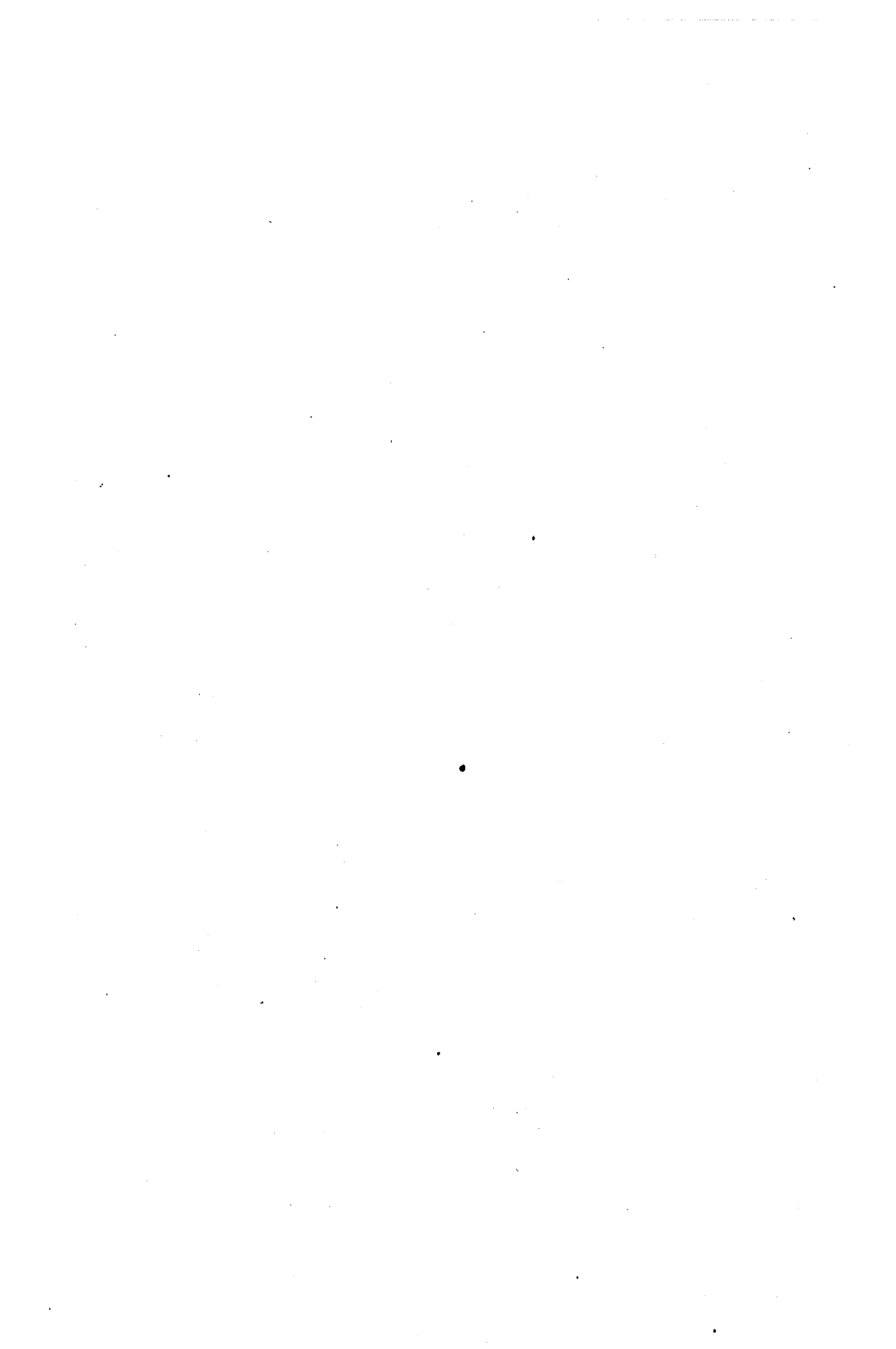
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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Whenever any railroad finished and in  
2 operation is not fenced, or its fences need repair, shall  
3 neglect to make or repair the same for thirty days,  
4 after written notice by any person to the superintend-  
5 ent or treasurer thereof, said corporation shall forfeit  
6 to the person giving said notice one hundred dollars,  
7 and shall be liable for all damages to any person on  
8 account of such neglect after seven days' notice as  
9 aforesaid.

SECT. 2. The twenty-first section of chapter fifty-  
2 one of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
