STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to certain literary institutions.

Resolved, That the state superintendent of common
2 schools be directed to inquire into the standing and
3 condition of the various chartered literary institutions
4 of the state, the amount of funds now held in trust by
5 them severally, the annual income of the same, and
6 the uses made thereof; and to inquire, specially,
7 what facilities are furnished by said institutions for the
8 education of public school teachers, and what number
9 of pupils in the past year have attended these institu-
10 tions with special reference to becoming qualified to
11 instruct in the public schools; and to communicate
12 the result of his inquiries in his next annual report.
