STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

RESOLVE transferring the cabinets of geology and mineralogy from the state house to the college of agriculture and mechanic arts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Resolved, That the governor and council are hereby
2 authorized and directed to transfer to the state college
3 of agriculture and the mechanic arts, at Orono, the
4 geological and mineralogical collections, and also the
5 Indian curiosities with the cases containing the same,
6 now in the corridors of the state house.
