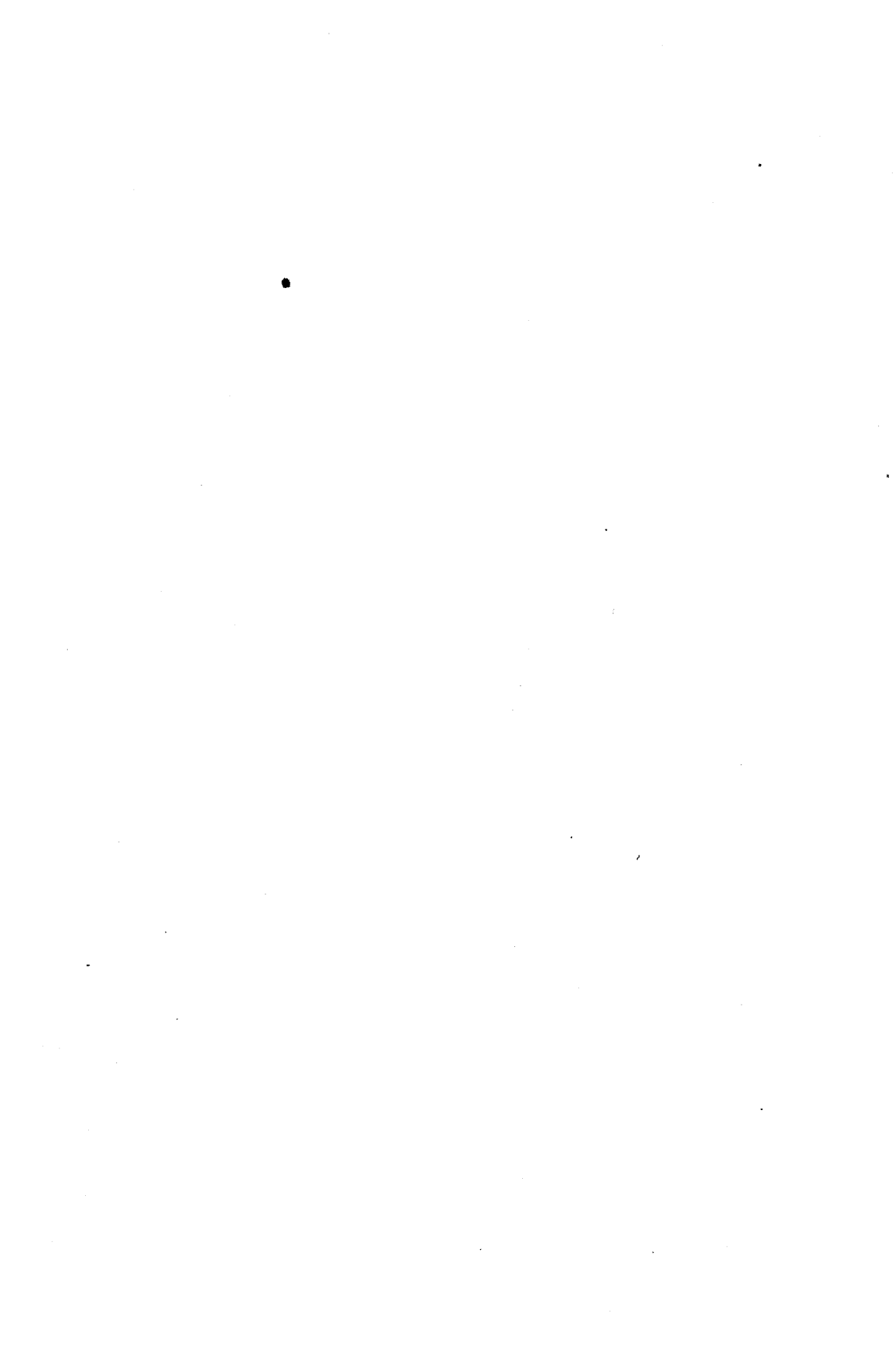
AN ACT authorizing railroad corporations to take lands for barrow and gravel pits.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Any railroad corporation may purchase  
2 or take and hold, as for public uses, land and the  
3 materials thereon, for barrow or gravel pits, outside of  
4 their road lines, for the construction and repair of its  
5 road, in the manner and under the restrictions pro-  
6 vided in chapter fifty-one, sections two and three of  
7 the revised statutes.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
