STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to the insane hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the governor and council be and
2 are hereby authorized and required to inquire into the
3 financial condition and management of the affairs of
4 the insane hospital, and make such changes as they
5 shall deem judicious in the mode and amount of
6 expenditures and the general administration of its
7 affairs.

SECT. 2. That the trustees of the insane hospital
2 shall quarterly, from and after January first, eighteen
3 hundred and seventy-one, audit all the accounts of the
4 steward and treasurer, make a report of their doings
5 to the governor and council, together with vouchers

6 for the several items, for their approval, before such
7 bills shall be allowed and paid.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on and after its
2 approval by the governor.
