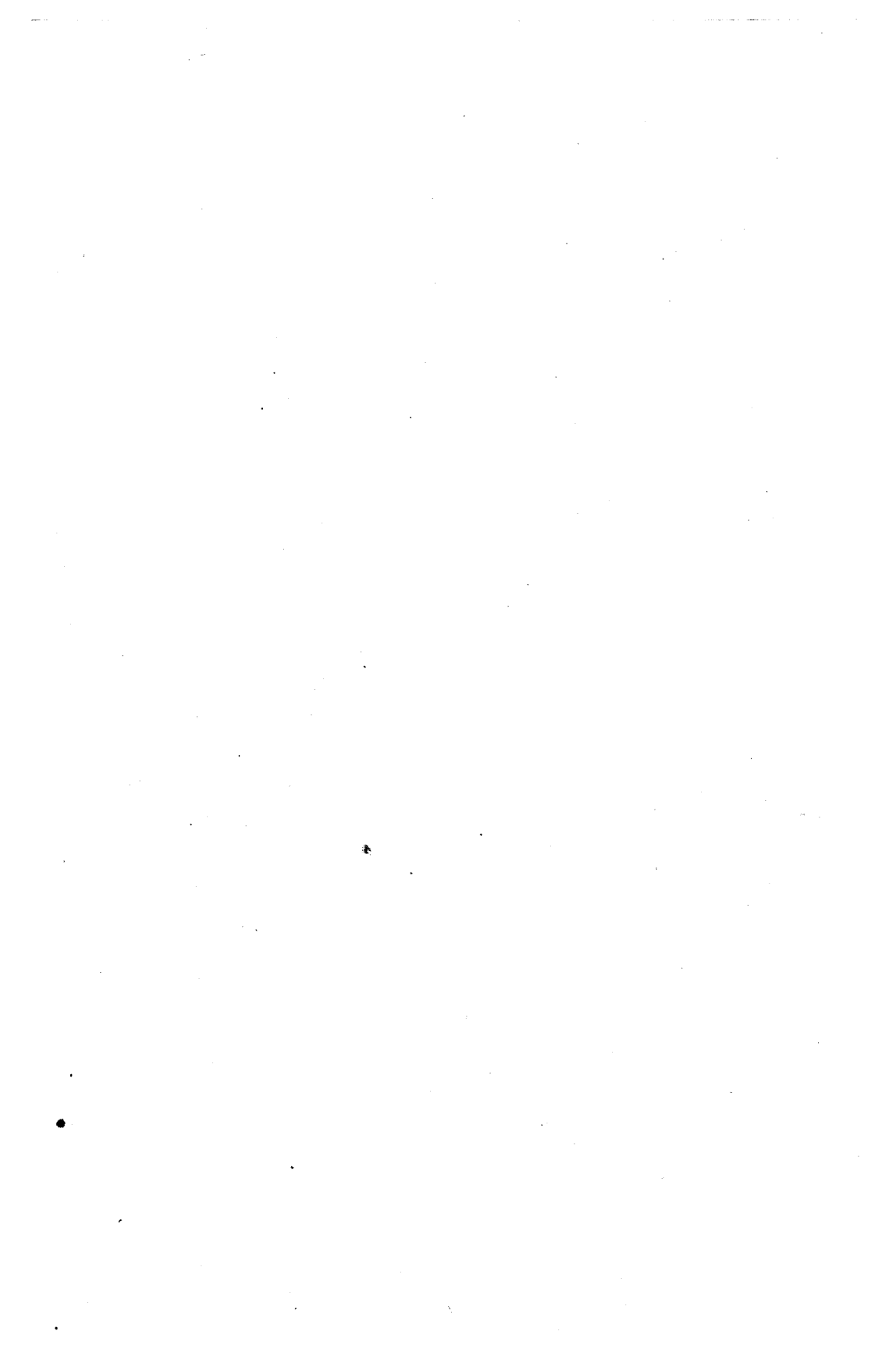
STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to the affairs of the office of special agent of the treasury department in Boston, having supervision over the State of Maine.

WHEREAS, the administration of the affairs of the
2 office of special agent of the treasury department
3 located at Boston, and having supervision over the
4 State of Maine, is believed by many to be a scandal
5 and a disgrace to the government of the United States
6 and an injury to the legitimate business of the State
7 of Maine, therefore

Resolved, That our senators in congress be requested,
2 and our representatives be instructed, to demand an
3 investigation by the senate committee on retrenchment
4 and reform, into the management of said office for the
5 last ten years.

Resolved, That the governor be requested to forward
2 a copy of these resolves to our senators and repre-
3 sentatives in congress.
