## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act empowering towns, cities and village corporations to make by-laws and ordinances in certain cases," approved February third, eighteen hundred and seventy-one.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The first section of chapter one hundred 2 seventy-eight of the public laws of eighteen hundred 3 seventy-one, is hereby amended so as to read as fol-4 lows, viz:

5 Section 1. Towns, cities and village corporations 6 may make such by-laws and ordinances, as they deem 7 proper, respecting the location and protection of monu-8 ments, boundary-stones, curb-stones, stepping-stones, 9 or horse-blocks, trees, lamp-posts, posts and hydrants, 10 and all other things, placed within the limits of their

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11 roads, ways and streets, by municipal authority and 12 for legitimate municipal purposes. And no monu-13 ments, boundary-stones, curb-stones, stepping-stones, 14 or horse-blocks, trees, lamp-posts, posts, hydrants, or 15 other objects placed as aforesaid, which are now 16 located, or shall hereafter be located in accordance 17 with the requirements of such by-laws and ordinances, 18 shall be deemed a defect in such road, way or street.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
