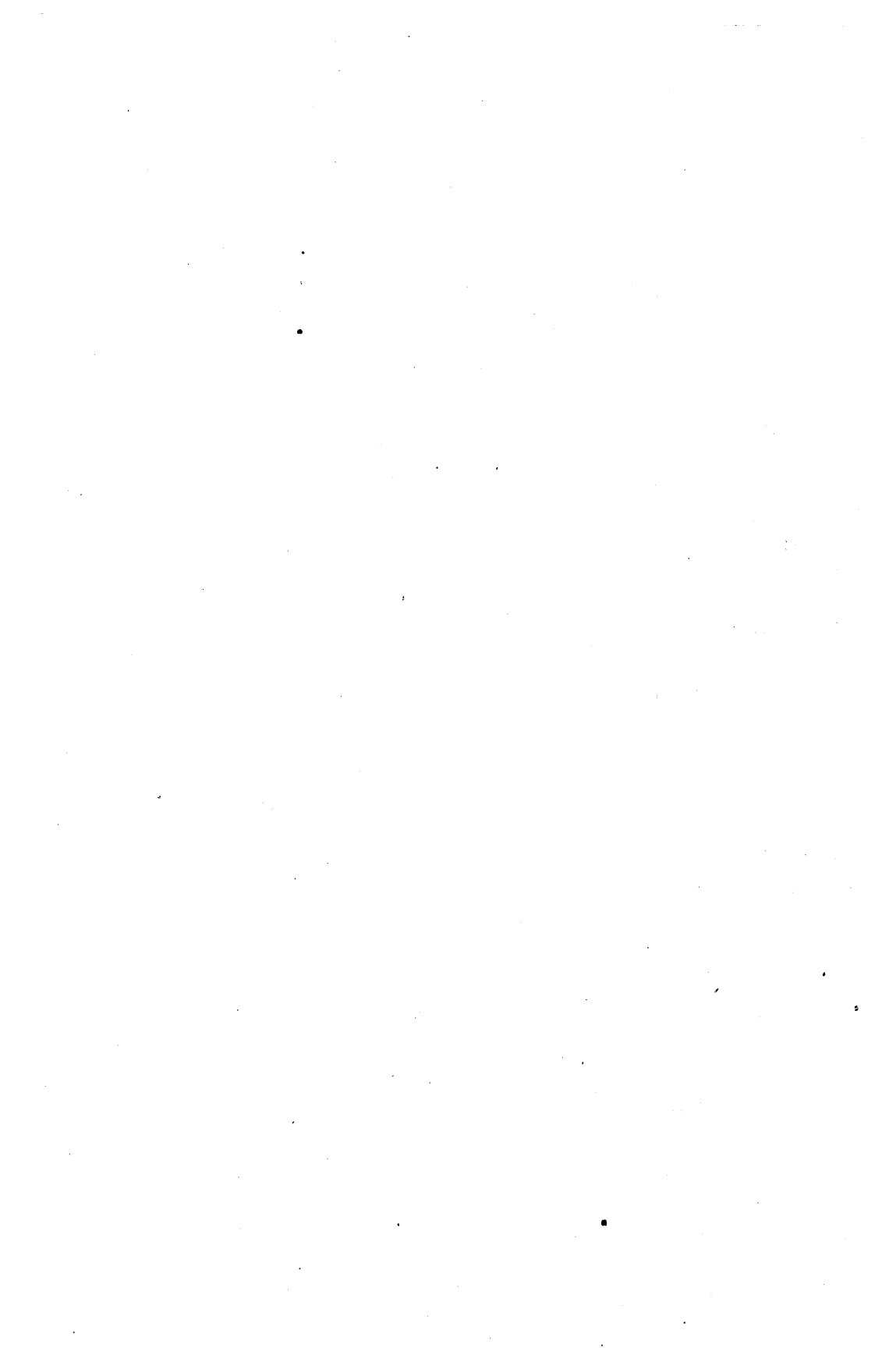
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to fix the compensation of the judges of the supreme judicial court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Each of the justices of the supreme
2 judicial court shall receive from the treasurer of state
3 a salary of three thousand dollars, in quarterly pay-
4 ments, on the first day of January, April, July and
5 October, each year, instead of the sums now allowed
6 them by law for salaries, board and travelling ex-
7 penses.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
