STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT authorizing the Maine Central Railroad Company to make a loan.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. The Maine Central Railroad Company 2 is hereby authorized to issue its bonds for the purpose 3 of providing means for putting said road and its equip- 4 ments, and the roads now leased to and operated by 5 it, in efficient condition, and for the payment of the 6 bonded debts and liabilities of said company and of 7 the corporations hereinafter named that unite in the 8 mortgage. And said Maine Central Railroad Com- 9 pany, and such of the following corporations whose 10 roads are now leased to and operated by it as shall 11 decide so to do, viz: the Portland and Kennebec Rail-

12 road Company, the Somerset and Kennebec Railroad
13 Company, the Leeds and Farmington Railroad Com-
14 pany, and the Androscoggin Railroad Company, are
15 hereby authorized to unite in a mortgage of their rail-
16 roads, franchises and other property to secure the pay-
17 ment of said bonds.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval
2 by the governor.
