## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT concerning railroad corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any railroad corporation may establish for its sole 2 benefit, fares, tolls and charges, upon all passengers 3 and property, conveyed and transported on its rail-4 road, at such rates as may be determined by the 5 directors thereof, and may from time to time by its 6 directors regulate the use of its road; *provided*, that 7 such rates of fares, tolls and charges, and regulations, 8 shall at all times be subject to revision and alteration 9 by the legislature, or such officers or persons as the 10 legislature may appoint for the purpose, anything in 11 the charter of any such railroad corporation to the 12 contrary notwithstanding.
