AN ACT additional to chapter five of the revised statutes, relating to trespass on public lands.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whenever any teams, implements, ap-

- 2 paratus and supplies are or shall be seized under the
- 3 provisions of section seven of chapter five of the
- 4 revised statutes, the land agent shall cause the same
- 5 to be sold at public auction, at such time and place
- 6 and with such notice as he shall deem expedient, and
- 7 the proceeds, after deducting expenses, charges and
- 8 fees, shall be paid into the state treasury, and an
- 9 account rendered by him thereof to the governor and
- 10 council at once.

- SECT. 2. This act shall apply to seizures made be-2 fore the passage of this act.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
