## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT relating to cases where demurrers are overruled.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The judgment upon the overruling of a
- 2 demurrer to an indictment for felony shall be that the
- 3 respondent shall plead to the indictment, unless the
- 4 law court shall adjudge the demurrer frivolous and
- 5 intended for delay, in which case judgment shall be
- 6 final.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
