AN ACT to change the punishment for burglary and rape.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. In all cases of burglary and rape, the
- 2 court may sentence for life or for a term of years.
- Sect. 2. This act shall take effect sixty days after 2 its approval.
