STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to incorporate the Oriental Powder Mills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Joseph H. Newhall, Joshua M. C. 2 Armsby, George M. Rice, Harrison Bliss, John W. 3 Candler, and Charles O. Foster, their associates, suc- 4 cessors and assigns, are hereby created and constituted 5 a body corporate and politic by the name of the 6 Oriental Powder Mills, with all the powers and privi- 7 leges, and subject to all the duties and liabilities of 8 manufacturing corporations.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is authorized to manu- 2 facture powder, dyestuffs and chemicals at Gambo 3 falls on the Presumpscot river, in the towns of Wind- 4 ham and Gorham, in the county of Cumberland, and

5 to manufacture goods, wares and fabrics of wood,
6 metal, glass, leather, paper, wool, cotton, silk or other
7 material on any of the falls on said Presumpscot river,
8 in said county of Cumberland, of which it is or may
9 become the owner or lessee; and for the purpose
10 aforesaid, may construct, repair and maintain upon
11 their own lands suitable dams, canals, water courses,
12 machine shops, buildings, and machinery; and may
13 purchase and hold such real estate and personal prop-
14 erty as may be necessary to effect the objects of their
15 incorporation; *provided* that it shall not hold real
16 estate exceeding in value the amount of its capital
17 stock.

SECT. 3. The capital stock of said corporation shall
2 not be less than two hundred thousand dollars, nor
3 more than one million dollars, divided into shares of
4 not less than one hundred dollars, nor more than one
5 thousand dollars.

SECT. 4. Any one of the persons named in this act
2 is authorized to call the first meeting of said corpora-
3 tion for the purpose of organizing said company, by
4 giving written notice to each of the others, setting
5 forth the time and place and purpose of said meeting
6 five days before said meeting.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force
2 when approved by the governor.
