STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to provide in part for the expenditures of gov-
ernment.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In order to provide for several acts and
2 resolves of the legislature requiring the payment of
3 money from the treasury, and also to provide for the
4 necessary expenditures of government for the current
5 fiscal year, the following sums are hereby appropriated
6 out of any moneys in the treasury, and the governor,
7 with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby
8 authorized at any time prior to the first day of January
9 next, to draw his warrant upon the treasury for the
10 same.
