STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls.

Resolved, That if the trustees of the Maine Industrial 2 School for Girls, shall secure the sum of thirty thou3 sand dollars within one year from the approval of this 4 resolve, either by donations of real or personal estate, 5 or in bona fide subscriptions of money, and deposit 6 satisfactory certificates of the same with the governor 7 and council, the governor and council are hereby 8 authorized to draw their warrant on the state treasurer 9 to the amount of ten thousand dollars in favor of said 10 trustees, to be by them expended for the benefit of said 11 school, with the advice and consent of the governor 12 and council.
