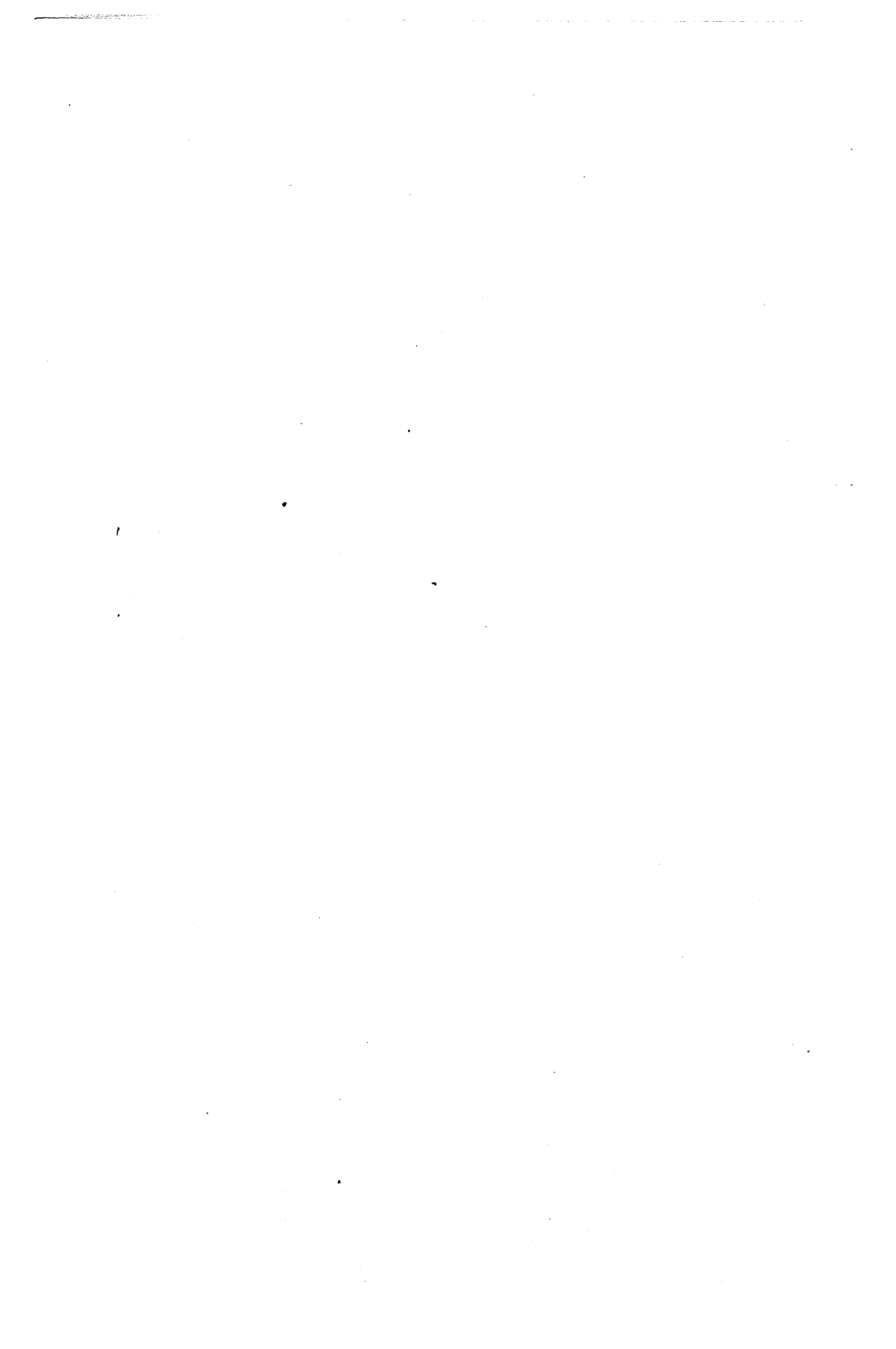
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to amend section eight of chapter ninety of the revised statutes, relating to actions on mortgages.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section eight of chapter ninety of the revised statutes is hereby amended, by inserting in the eighth line, next after the word "judgment," the following:

4 And if, after the expiration of three years from the
5 time of the rendition of the judgment, the writ of
6 possession has not been served or the judgment wholly
7 satisfied, another conditional judgment may, on scire
8 facias sued out in the name of the mortgagee or as-
9 signee, be rendered, and a writ of possession issued as
10 before provided.
