IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to amend section ten of chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes, relating to promissory notes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Section ten of chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes is amended by adding thereto the following :

And no contract between the holder and principal of a promissory note for the extension of the time of payment thereof shall operate to discharge any surety or endorser thereon unless it is in writing and signed by the holder.
