AN ACT to amend section ten of chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes, relating to promissory notes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section ten of chapter thirty-two of the revised stat-

- 3 And no contract between the holder and principal of
- 4 a promissory note for the extension of the time of pay-
- 5 ment thereof shall operate to discharge any surety or
- 6 endorser thereon unless it is in writing and signed by
- 7 the holder.
