STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of county commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Each county commissioner for the counties of Androscoggin, Aroostook, Franklin, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Penobscot, Piscataquis, Sagadahoc, Somerset, Waldo, Washington and York, shall have three dollars a day, and in that proportion for parts of a day, while actually employed in the service of the county, exclusive of the time spent in travelling, for which he shall have ten cents a mile for the distance actually travelled, but he shall not have more than one travel in the same case.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of March, A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-two.
