STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of county commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Each county commissioner for the coun-
- 2 ties of Androscoggin, Aroostook, Franklin, Hancock,
- 3 Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Oxford, Penobscot, Pis-
- 4 cataquis, Sagadahoc, Somerset, Waldo, Washington
- 5 and York, shall have three dollars a day, and in that
- 6 proportion for parts of a day, while actually employed
- 7 in the service of the county, exclusive of the time
- 8 spent in travelling, for which he shall have ten cents
- 9 a mile for the distance actually travelled, but he shall
- 10 not have more than one travel in the same case.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day
 - 2 of March, A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-two.
