## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to amend section sixty-five of chapter eighteen of the revised statutes, relating to injuries by defect in ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The first clause of section sixty-five of
- 2 chapter eighteen of the revised statutes is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out the word "three," in the
- 4 fifth line thereof, and inserting in place thereof the
- 5 word 'two,' so that the same, as amended, shall read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 "Sect. 65. If any person receives any bodily in-
- 8 jury, or suffers any damage in his property, through
- 9 any defect or want of repair or sufficient railing in any
- 10 highway, townway, causeway, or bridge, he may re-

- 11 cover the same in a special action on the case, to be
- 12 commenced within two years from the date of receiv-
- 13 ing such injury, or suffering such damage, of the
- 14 county, town, or person obliged by law to repair the
- 15 same, if such county, town or person had reasonable
- 16 notice of the defect or want of repair."
  - Sect. 2. This act shall not affect any action for the
  - 2 recovery of damages sustained prior to the approval
  - 3 thereof.
