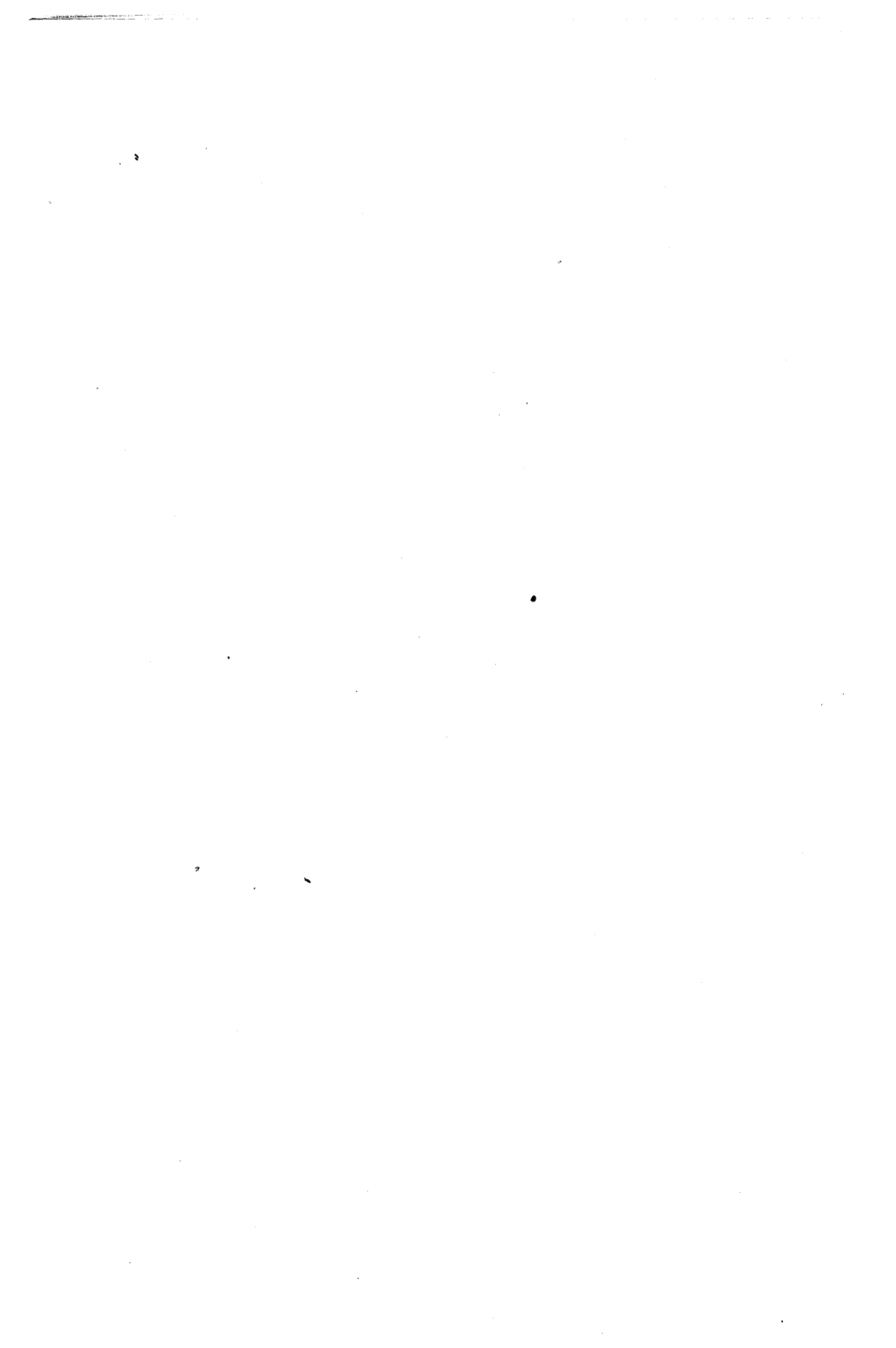
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### AN ACT relating to common carriers.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

All common carriers in this state, shall within twenty-  
2 four hours after demand made on either of them there-  
3 for, furnish to any person or persons, for whom they  
4 carry any goods, wares, merchandise or other property,  
5 a bill of particulars, setting forth each item thereof,  
6 and the amount of freight or toll charged on each of  
7 said items ; and any such common carrier who shall  
8 unreasonably neglect or refuse to comply with the pro-  
9 visions of this act shall forfeit and pay to the person or  
10 persons aggrieved thereby, a sum not less than twenty  
11 dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, to be re-  
12 covered in an action on the case in any court compe-  
13 tent to try the same.
