IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT relating to common carriers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

All common carriers in this state, shall within twenty-

- 2 four hours after demand made on either of them there-
- 3 for, furnish to any person or persons, for whom they
- 4 carry any goods, wares, merchandise or other property,
- 5 a bill of particulars, setting forth each item thereof,
- 6 and the amount of freight or toll charged on each of
- 7 said items; and any such common carrier who shall
- 8 unreasonably neglect or refuse to comply with the pro-
- 9 visions of this act shall forfeit and pay to the person or
- 10 persons aggrieved thereby, a sum not less than twenty
- 11 dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, to be re-
- 12 covered in an action on the case in any court compe-
- 13 tent to try the same.
