STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to prevent coasting and sliding on the travelled roads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Whoever slides with a sled or other ve-
- 2 hicle on the travelled roads, or on the sidewalks
- 3 of any city or town without a written license from the
- 4 municipal officers thereof, shall be subject to a fine of
- 5 five dollars for each offence, to be recovered on com-
- 6 plaint, to the use of the town where the offense is com-
- 7 mitted.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
