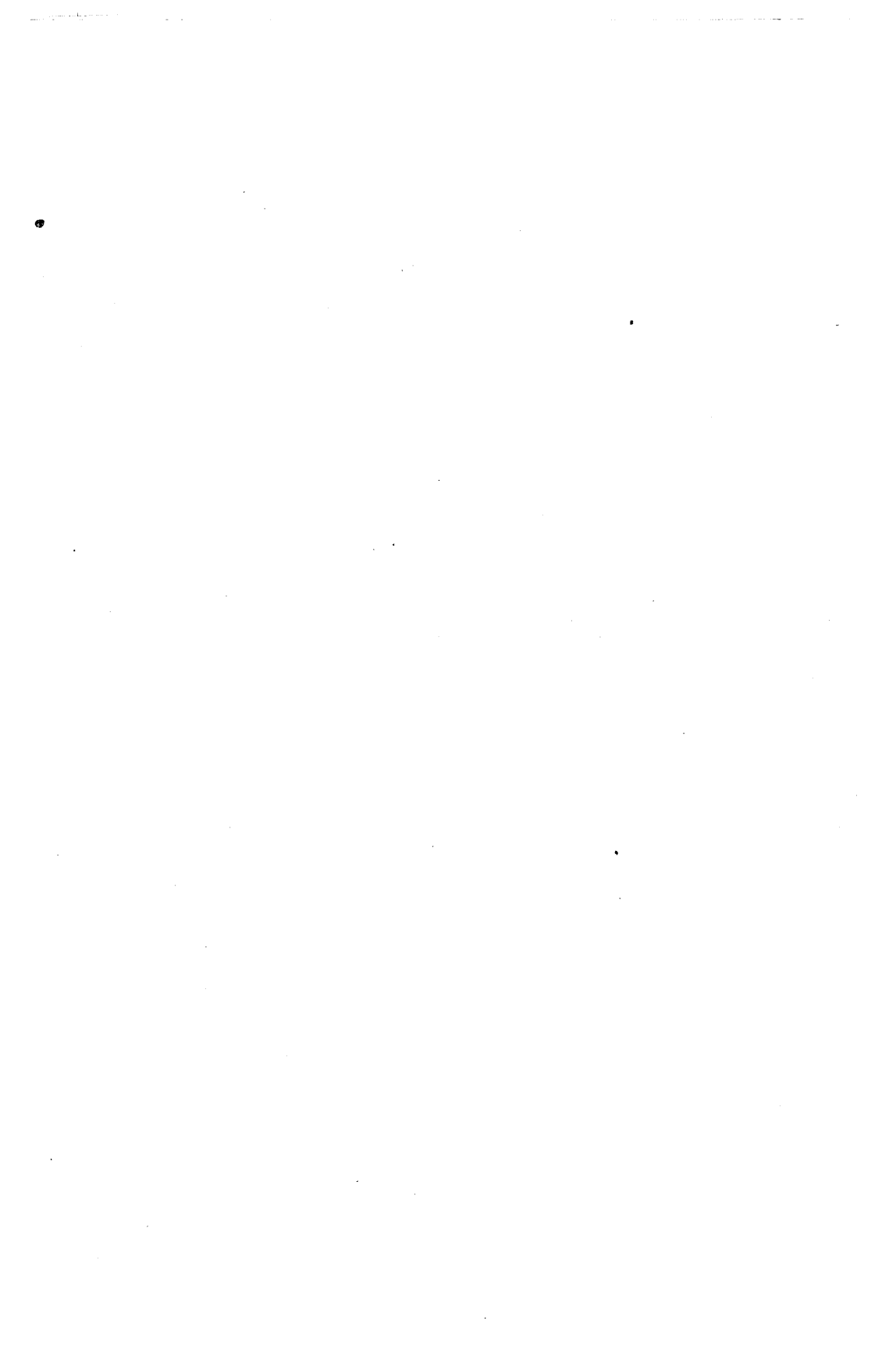
AN ACT to prevent coasting and sliding on the travelled roads.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Whoever slides with a sled or other vehicle on the travelled roads, or on the sidewalks of any city or town without a written license from the municipal officers thereof, shall be subject to a fine of five dollars for each offence, to be recovered on complaint, to the use of the town where the offense is committed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
