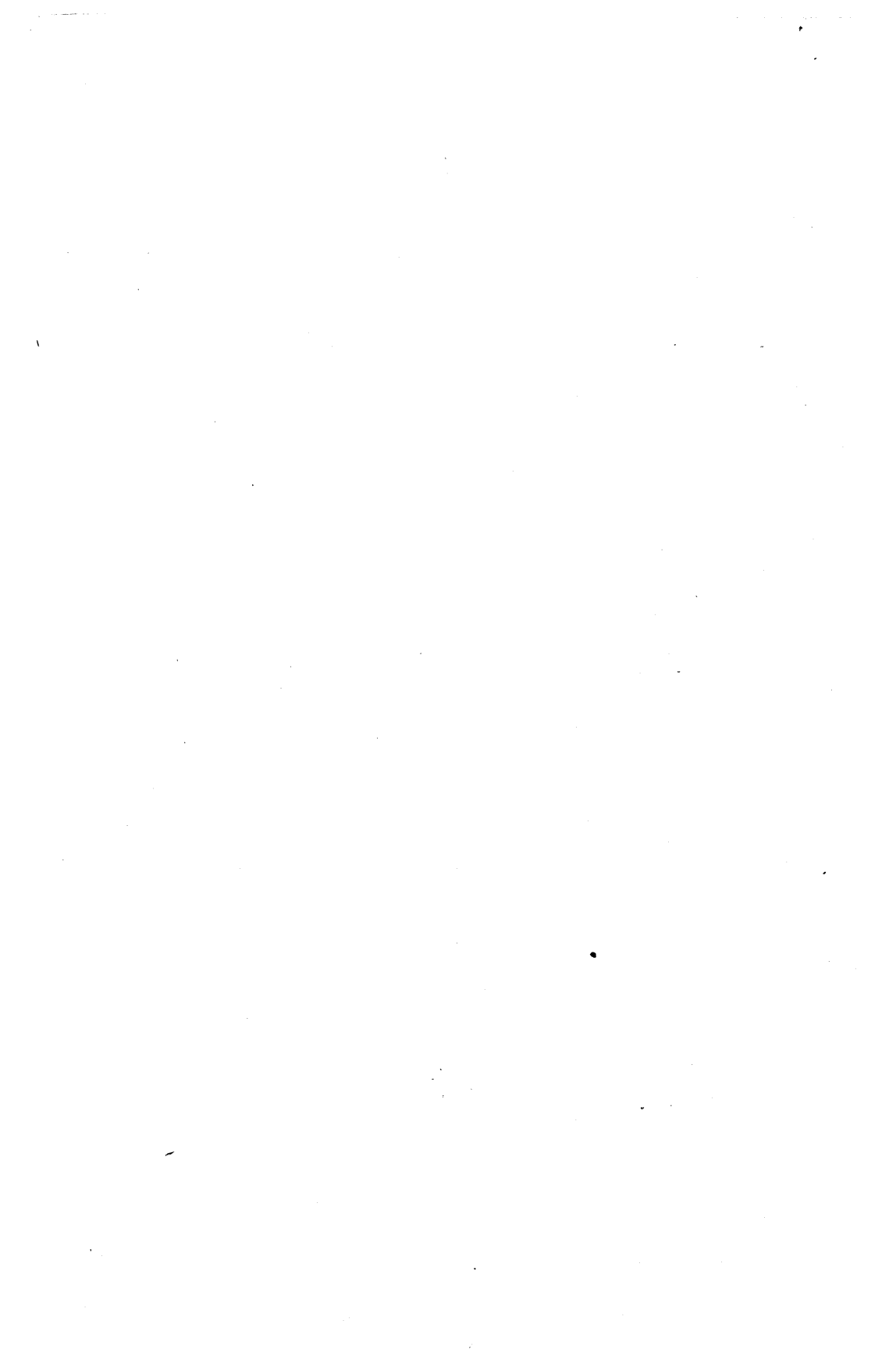
Ordered, That the Clerk be directed to prepare and print for the use of the House, a list of all appropriations of money reported to the Legislature, and for what purpose.
