STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on the several counties in the state.

Resolved, That the sums annexed to the counties in
2 the following schedule are hereby granted as a tax on
3 each county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed,
4 collected, and applied, for the purpose of paying the
5 debts, and necessary expenses of the same, and other
6 purposes ordered by law, to wit :

7 Androscoggin, thirty thousand dollars.
8 Aroostook, twelve thousand dollars.
9 Cumberland, fifty thousand dollars.
10 Franklin, eight thousand dollars.
11 Hancock, ten thousand dollars.
12 Kennebec, thirty-two thousand dollars.
13 Knox, eleven thousand five hundred dollars.
14 Lincoln, nine thousand dollars.
15 Oxford, thirteen thousand dollars.

- 16 Penobscot, thirty-five thousand dollars.
- 17 Piscataquis, six thousand dollars.
- 18 Sagadahoc, sixteen thousand dollars.
- 19 Somerset, twelve thousand dollars.
- 20 Waldo, twelve thousand seven hundred dollars.
- 21 Washington, fifteen thousand dollars.
- 22 York, thirty-five thousand dollars.
