STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT to amend chapter sixty-six, section four, of the revised statutes relating to commissioners of insolvent estates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter sixty-six of the 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by adding the 3 following to wit: "If any one or more of the com- 4 missioners shall die after the expiration of the eighteen 5 months, and before the commission is returned, the 6 judge of probate may appoint new commissioners and 7 allow an additional time not exceeding three months 8 for the presentation of claims."

SECT. 2. Section twenty of chapter sixty-six of the 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by adding the

3 following words, to wit: “The rents and profits of
4 the real estate belonging to any insolvent estate, and
5 all damages recovered for waste or trespasses com-
6 mitted thereon, shall be considered and treated as a
7 part of the estate for the payment of debts.”

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
