IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT additional to chapter eighty-three of the revised statutes, concerning justice actions.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In actions in a municipal or police court  
2 or before a trial justice, either party after appearing  
3 and filing his pleadings, may waive a trial and give  
4 the adverse party judgment, and then appeal the same  
5 as if there had been an actual trial.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
