STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

AN ACT authorizing railroad corporations to take lands for borrow and gravel pits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Any railroad corporation may purchase or take and
2 hold, as for public uses, land and the materials there-
3 on, for borrow or gravel pits, for the construction and
4 repair of its road, in the manner and under the re-
5 strictions provided in chapter fifty-one, sections two
6 and three, of the revised statutes.
