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## STATE OF MAINE.

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RESOLVE providing for a meeting of judges of probate  
for certain purposes.

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*Resolved,* That the several judges of probate in this  
2 state, be authorized to hold a meeting during the en-  
3 suing year, at such time and place as they may desig-  
4 nate, for consultation upon the practice and modes of  
5 proceeding in the probate courts in the several counties,  
6 with a view of improvement and greater uniformity  
7 therein; that the travelling and other necessary ex-  
8 penses of said judges in attending said meeting, be  
9 paid by the state; and that the governor is hereby  
10 authorized to draw his warrant on the treasury for that  
11 purpose, for a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars.
