STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for a meeting of judges of probate for certain purposes.

Resolved, That the several judges of probate in this

- 2 state, be authorized to hold a meeting during the en-
- 3 suing year, at such time and place as they may desig-
- 4 nate, for consultation upon the practice and modes of
- 5 proceeding in the probate courts in the several counties,
- 6 with a view of improvement and greater uniformity
- 7 therein; that the travelling and other necessary ex-
- 8 penses of said judges in attending said meeting, be
- 9 paid by the state; and that the governor is hereby
- 10 authorized to draw his warrant on the treasury for that
- 11 purpose, for a sum not exceeding three hundred dollars.
