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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO.

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AN ACT to fix the compensation of the county commissioners of Kennebec county.

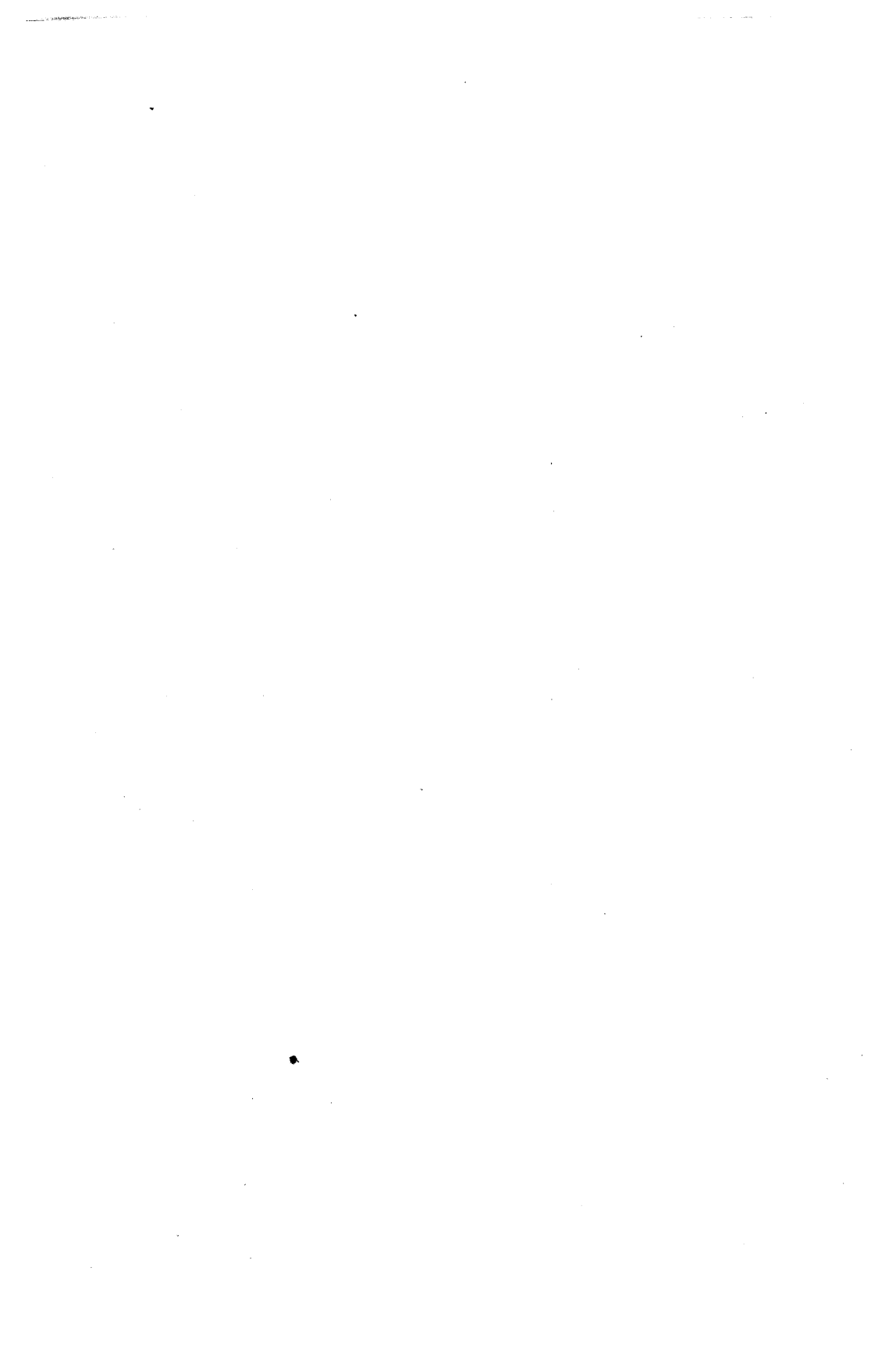
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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The pay of the county commissioners of  
2 Kennebec county shall be three dollars a day each, for  
3 services while actually employed in official business,  
4 including the time necessarily spent in travelling and  
5 in making draughts, and shall receive for travel twelve  
6 cents a mile for the distance actually travelled.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with  
2 this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its  
2 approval.
